INEPAS is a non-profit organization, founded in 1994, legally constituted and fully recognized by the Guatemalan state for performing a range of social, legal, and humanitarian projects within the community development framework in the Quetzaltenango area.

Since its founding, INEPAS has led various social and educational support efforts and projects. Among others, the major one was the foundation of a community school in a Mayan-K'iché community where community self-management was promoted. This successful community school was recognized by UNESCO headquarters in Paris as an innovative educational project that could serve as a model for similar community development projects in Guatemala and around the world. As a result, UNESCO financed the production of a documentary video about the Choquiac School that has been translated into various languages and distributed to over 156 countries.
